## TOP TIPS/How to Submit

*Auction This* is a Ramp Gallery initiative to support the creative endeavours of Wintec Media Arts students. The event provides an opportunity to showcase Media Arts talent with the wider Hamilton arts community, friends and family members, whilst providing a platform for the sale of artwork created within the last 2 years. Ramp Gallery takes no commission on the artworks, with the full price of sale handed directly from the buyer to the artist on the night of the auction.

### **Important Dates**

**Proposal Due Date:** Monday 2 November 2020

**Successful Proposals notified by:** Monday 9 November 2020

**Delivery Date:** Artworks *must* be received on Thursday 12 November 2020 (between 10am and 2pm only).

**Address for Delivery:** Ramp Gallery (between 10am and 2pm only). All artworks will receive a receipt on delivery. Please do not leave artworks without having received a receipt.

**Exhibition Dates:** Ramp Gallery - Monday 23 November to Thursday 26 November 2020

**Opening Event:** End of year shows opening night on Thursday 26 November 2020

**Return of work:** Any unsold work must be collected by Tuesday 1 December 2020.

### **How to set a reserve**

- The reserve price is the minimum bid you wish to accept.
- The audience of *Auction This* are generally family members, friends and other students. Please keep this in mind when setting your reserve price.
- Check with other students and family members to see if the reserve price feels right to them.
- To keep costs down some things to consider are printing or painting a smaller Artwork to keep your outgoing costs down.

### **Packaging, Size Restrictions & Artworks with Multiple Pieces**

- Artworks must be well packaged and labelled, with no exposed edges or faces.
- Ensure all artwork is labelled with your name, phone number and title of the work.
- All artwork must have fixtures attached ready to hang.
- We recommend you use quality frames or leave the work unframed.

- Places you might consider to go for quality framing are Imageland, Framing House, Factory Frames (Auckland) & Framing Workshop.
- All artworks must fit within a 2 x 2 metre space within the Gallery, so as to accommodate other submissions.
- Objects are welcome to be submitted and must fit on a standard gallery plinth or table.
- Artworks that contain multiple pieces such as Diptychs can be submitted, however they must still follow the size restrictions as outlined above.
- Ramp Gallery will be responsible for all curatorial decisions.
